Houses into Homes is 501c3 nonprofit organization that provides gently-used beds, furniture, and household items for families and individuals in Johnson County who are exiting homelessness, domestic violence, and other crisis situations. The intern will work with a collaborative team of 8 employees and numerous dedicated volunteers. The internship is 6-15 hours per week.
